Program Information:

The Seattle Language and Culture Institute (SLCI) is an opportunity for middle and high school students to take part in a two-week global experience on the University of Washington campus in Seattle, Washington.

The SLCI is a powerful way for students to build cultural competency, practice communication and diplomacy skills, make friends from around the world, and become not just global citizens, but global leaders.

Local participants will take part in sessions focused on leadership, international awareness, and cultural competency. Afternoon excursions will inspire sharing and cultural exchange while enjoying Seattle and the Puget Sound region.

In addition to daily activities, students will take part in a weekend camp experience and visit Mount Rainier with the international participants.



As part of a cohort of young people learning alongside international participants of the same age, students in the Seattle Language and Culture Institute will develop deep cultural awareness, global perspective, and enduring friendships with other youth around the world.

Program Quick Facts:



- The Seattle Language and Culture Institute welcomes up to 80 international and domestic participants; both group and individual enrollment is welcome
- Students should be entering 8th – 11th grade and be between 13-17 years old
- Students will meet each morning on the UW campus at 9:00 am and conclude most afternoons at 5:00 pm
- Includes a two-day, one-night overnight camp experience at Pack Forest Retreat Center and visit to Mount Rainier
- Local students who need language support can select the English track in lieu of the global leadership track
- All lunches, transportation, entry fees, and curriculum are included in the

program cost of \$550; a limited number of partial scholarships are available
