We're looking for 24 youth, ages 12-15, who are **SERIOUSLY** into art and **MOTIVATED** to make **CHANGE** in the community. We are looking for students who are innovators, creative, and hard workers, who can maintain focus while having fun and sharing ideas.

The 2017 team will participate in **ONE** of **TWO** major projects:

Team 1: Visual Arts

AM | 9:30-1:00

12 Students will work with a professional artist to create freestanding and interactive sculptures out of old doors. Students will be asked to respond to the theme: Home and Access. The project will be displayed at a community event on July 22nd at Powell Barnett Park. In the project, students will explore design, painting techniques, and use professional tools as they work in the woodshop.

Team 2: Performing Arts

PM | 1:30-5:00

12 Students will work with a professional performance artist to explore poetry, spoken word, sound and movement to create a performance piece that expresses Home and Access. The performance and the sculptures will be presented at a community event on July 22nd at Powell Barnett Park.

Each youth will earn up to **\$200 as a stipend** for full participation and hard work.

Week 2: Monday - Friday, July 17th – July 21st
